Tenders must be accompanied by the following where applicable:

- (i) Valid **Income Tax and Valued Added Tax Clearance Certificates** issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date for submission of proposals.
- (ii) A Valid **Certificate of Compliance** issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.
