Tender for the Raising, Removal and Disposal of Marine Wrecks for the Maritime Services Division, Ministry of Transport

Tenders are invited for the Raising, Removal and Disposal of Marine Wrecks for the Maritime Services Division, Ministry of Transport at the following three (3) Areas:

- Area 1: The waters of the Port of Spain Harbour and environs,
- Area 2: The waters of the Sea Lots area and environs and
- Area 3: The waters of the San Fernando/Claxton Bay areas and Southern Gulf of Paria and environs.

Tenderers are advised that one (1) Area may be awarded per contractor or a combination of Areas.

A pre-tender meeting followed by a site visit will be held for prospective tenderers at **9.30 a.m. on Friday August 29, 2014** at the Ministry of Transport's Office, International Water Front Complex, Tower D- Level 23, #1A Wrightson Road, Port of Spain.

Tenders must be accompanied by the following:

- (i) Valid Income Tax and Valued Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender.
- (ii) A Valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

The original and six (6) copies of the Tender should be placed in sealed envelopes addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain. Envelopes must be deposited in the **BROWN** Tenders Box, located in the lobby of the Board's Office not later than **1:00 p.m. on Thursday September 11, 2014.**

Envelopes must be clearly marked on the outside: -

“Tender for the Raising, Removal and Disposal of Marine Wrecks for the Maritime Services Division, Ministry of Transport”

Tenders will be opened shortly thereafter. The tenderer or an authorized representative may be present at the opening.

Tenderers should note that the dimensions of the **SLOT** of the Tenders Box are **37.5 cm x 5.5 cm** and, as such, tenders should be packaged accordingly.

Late tenders will not be considered in any circumstances.

The Board does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender.

The Central Tenders Board reserves the right to cancel the bidding process in its entirety or even partially, without defraying any cost incurred by any firm in submitting their tender.
