Tenders are invited for the following three (3) Rural Access Roads Projects under the Rehabilitative Maintenance Programme for the Land and Water Development Division, Ministry of Agriculture, Land and Marine Resources 2008/2009:

- (i) Periodic Maintenance of Agricultural Access Roads (7 Contracts)
- (ii) Oilsand Sealing of Agricultural Access Roads (5 Contracts)
- (iii) Rehabilitation of Agricultural Access Roads (6 Contracts)

**It is to be noted that only one contract will be awarded per tenderer.**

Tenderers are required to pay a tender deposit of **one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00)** by cash or certified cheque to the Director of Contracts and **attach the original receipt to their tender**. This tender deposit will be received from Monday to Friday between the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon and 1:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m.

A pre-tender meeting will be held at **9:30 a.m. on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> February, 2009** at the Conference Room of the Land and Water Development Division, Ministry of Agriculture Land and Marine Resources, Centeno at which time arrangements would be made to visit the sites.

Prospective tenderers are required to attend site visits in order to acquaint themselves with conditions which may influence their tender.

Tenders must be accompanied by the following:

- (i) Valid Income Tax and Valued Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue.
- (ii) A Valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

The Bills of Quantities and Tender Form must be submitted in **duplicate** in separately sealed envelopes from the Prequalification Data. Envelopes must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain and deposited in the **BROWN** Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board's Office before **1:00 p.m. on THURSDAY 12<sup>TH</sup> MARCH, 2009.**

**Only the envelope containing the pre-qualification data will be opened on the closing date shortly thereafter.** The tenderer or his representative may be present at the opening.
