Further Extension of Time for the Board of Inland Revenue to Issue Notices of Assessment

The Ministry of Finance wishes to advise that the time period for the Board of Inland Revenue to issue a Notice of Assessment has been further extended from <u>July 31, 2024</u> to <u>August 16, 2024</u> *vide* Legal Notice No. 132 of 2024 (see the Legal Notice attached).


This has become necessary to permit the Board to dispatch all remaining Revised Notices of Assessment for Property Tax to residential land owners and occupiers not yet in receipt of same.

Further, pursuant to *Legal Notice No. 48 of 2024*, residential land owners and occupiers, who meet the requirements under the Property Tax Act, may make an application to the Board of Inland Revenue for deferral of Property Tax (see the Deferral Form attached).

The public is also reminded that pursuant to *Property Tax (Amendment) Act, 2024*, the rate of Property Tax was decreased from 3% to 2%.
